ICOM Italy established on 2007 a thematic commission for museum accessibility.

A lively debate, with both Italian and foreign colleagues, arose the opportunity of creating an International Committee for museum **accessibility**, **inclusion and usability**. Such an interdisciplinary and complex theme (motor, sensory and cognitive disabilities, social frailty, etc.) should be discussed in a participatory manner.

Many **governments** are now finally concentrating on this theme and the Italian Ministry of Culture recently created a dedicated working group.
